Parents, spectators & coaches code of conduct

1. **Children play organised sports for fun.** They are not miniature professionals. They are not playing for the entertainment of spectators only.
2. **Applaud** good performances and efforts by your team AND the opponents. **Congratulate** BOTH teams upon their performance regardless of the game's outcome. **Show respect** for your children's opponents.
3. **Encourage** players to play according to the rules and the official's decisions. **Respect** the official's decision and teach the children to do likewise. If there is a disagreement, follow the appropriate procedure in order to question the decision
4. **Positive** comments are motivational. Look for what the child is doing well and tell them so.
5. **Never ridicule or scold** a child for making a mistake in a competition.
6. **Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour** by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches or officials. Always look for something good to say about the situation.
7. **Condemn** the use of violence in any form, be it from coaches, spectators, officials or players.

Parents are responsible to make sure that the children are fully supervised before and after basketball games. While Newlands makes every effort to keep players away from dangers, it is not our responsibility to child mind. Please make sure that children are supervised at all times. Any damage caused by unsupervised players is the responsibility of their parents/guardians.

Parents should consider how they can contribute to the club, and be prepared to find out how you can give some of your time, expertise or support. There are a multitude of ways to help and assist the children to have fun, develop their skills and ensure that everyone gets a go and knows what's going on.

We are all volunteers. We have an expectation and believe that every parent can share the load of making this a successful club by helping out. Choose how you would like to do it.

Players's code of conduct

1. Understand and play by the rules.
2. Respect referees and other officials.
3. Control your temper.
4. Work equally hard for yourself and for your team.
5. Be a good sport.
6. Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
7. Play for the "enjoyment of it" and not just to please your parents and coaches.
8. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person.
9. Be prepared to lose sometimes.
10. Listen to the advice of your coach and try to apply it at practice and in games.
11. Always respect the use of the facilities and equipment provided.
12. You are not allowed play or participate in any activity if you are under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
